

CADREI Constitution

I. NAME

The Council of Academic Deans from Research Education Institutions

II. PURPOSE The purpose of this Council and its affiliates shall be the consideration of questions relating to the promotion of the preparation of education personnel in all its phases in the Universities and Land-Grant Colleges of the several states of the Union and the discussion of such questions and formulation of such plans, policies and programs as may tend to make the member institutes of the Council more effective in their work. No funds of the Council shall be used to support a political candidate.

III. MEMBERSHIP Membership in CADREI shall be confined to those institutions which are currently members of the NASULGC and to independent HBCU's and institutions which offer doctoral work in education which, in the judgment of the Executive Committee, are comparable in mission and scope to the NASULGC institutions.

IV. REPRESENTATIVE The chief administrative officer of the School, College or Department of Education in each institution shall be the official representative from each institution.

V. DUES The Executive Committee shall be responsible for recommending to the membership the amount of institutional dues. Any dues increase must be approved by a majority vote of members present at an Council business meeting.

VI. MEETINGS The dates and sites of meetings of the Council shall be determined by the Executive Committee unless such dates and sites are otherwise specifically directed at an Association business meeting.

VII. OFFICERS There shall be five elected officers:

- President (two-year term)
- President-Elect (one-year term in alternate years)
- Past President (one-year term in alternate years)
- Secretary (three-year term)
- Treasurer (three-year term)

and an Executive Committee of nine (9) members constituted as follows:

- Three (3) shall be the President, Secretary, and Treasurer
- Four (4) shall be elected at large
- One (1) shall be elected from the membership of the Affiliated Private Universities
- One (1) shall be President-Elect or Past-President (in alternate years)

VIII. COMMITTEES

Committees shall be established and appointed by the Executive Committee of the Council.
